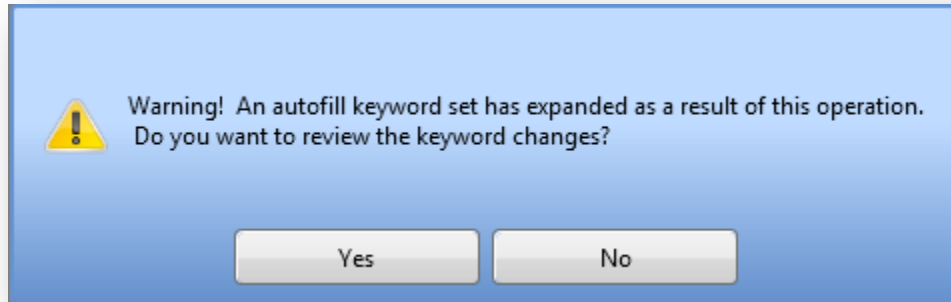



# Autofill Keyword Set Warning When Batch Indexing in Unity

**Question:** While indexing in Unity Batch Indexing an error is thrown when I click Index



To prevent this error from displaying you must **Tab** after entering your primary keyword value to autofill the rest of your keyword values.

This error will display if any other key is used, for example the keypads **down arrow**
